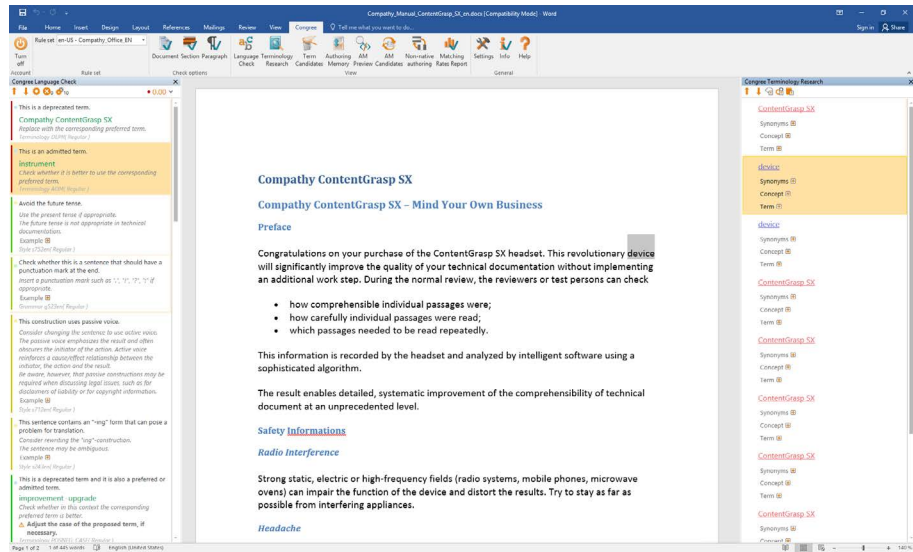


Congree for Microsoft® Word

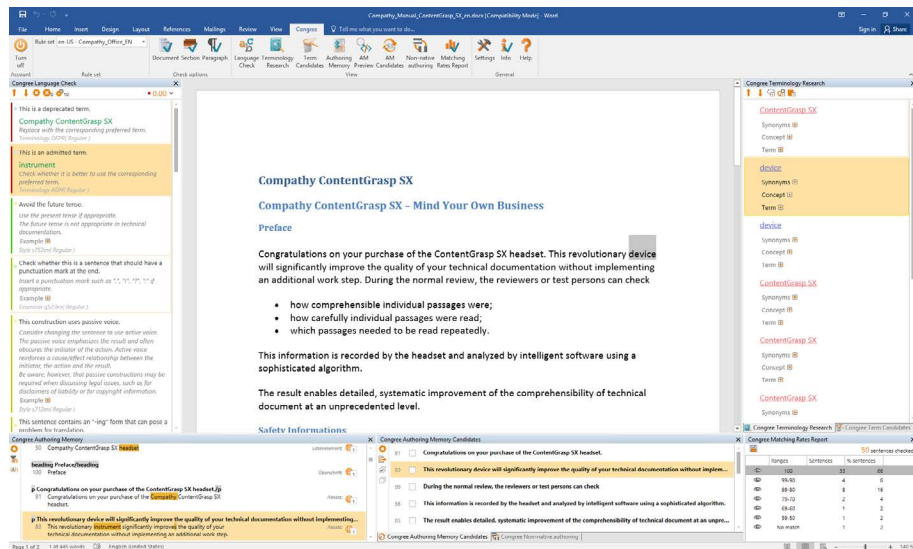
Our Philosophy

While Congree blends in perfectly with the user interfaces of the editors, the presentation and check results remain uniform and consistent for all editors. Thus, you can always expect the same Congree quality, no matter which editor you use. » Example Congree application scenario: Language Check and Terminology Research



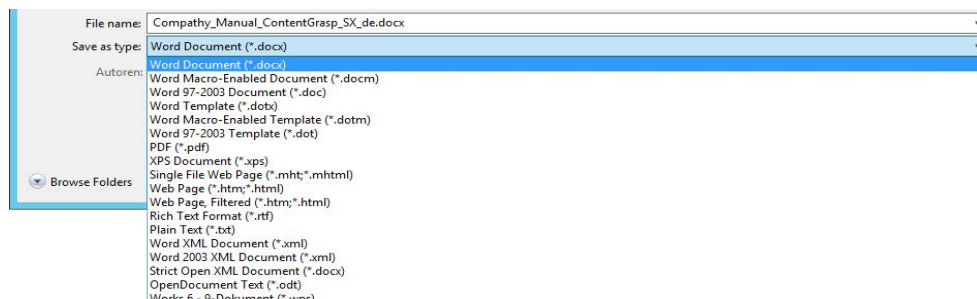
» Display of additional Congree functions

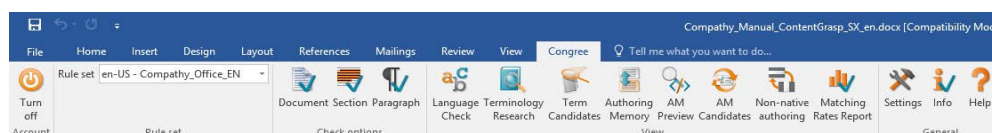
... Different Microsoft® Word File Types

With the Congree Authoring Server integration for Microsoft® Word, you can check all file types supported by Microsoft® Word. The results are always the same, no matter whether you work with plain text, XML, or the accustomed DOC/DOCX format.

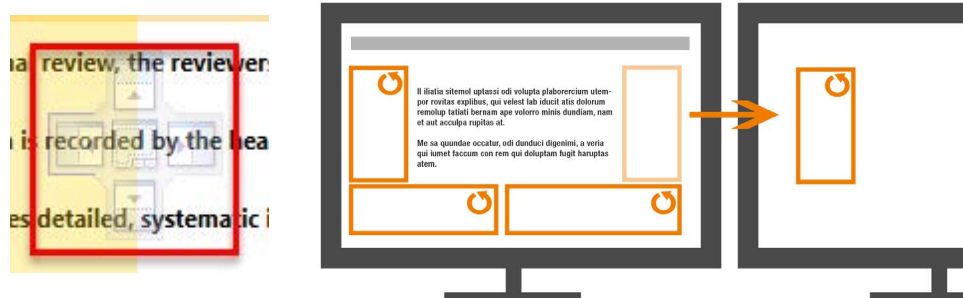


The Congree Toolbar

... as an Additional Microsoft® Office Ribbon Tab



You can flexibly show or hide all Congree panels depending on your duties or under consideration of your workflows. Click a button in the "View" area in the "Congree" tab to show or hide the particular panel. The Congree integration in Microsoft® Word supports flexible detachment, repositioning, and docking of Congree panels in the text editor. Thus, you can organize your panels as you wish, stack them, or even move them to another monitor, e.g. in order to maximize the editing area:

... with Several Opened Microsoft® Word Instances

Congree for Microsoft® Word operates across separate windows. Thus, you can work with Congree concurrently in several instances of Microsoft® Word, but in a shared context.
